The Connected Learning Initiative (CLIX), which the flagship programme of the Centre was awarded the UNESCO-King Hamad Prize for the Use of ICTs in Education (2017 edition).

The Centre is actively engaged in research, development, teaching, field action/action research and advocacy, and offers opportunities for national and international collaboration, innovation and excellence in teaching and research. *The Centre is initiating programmes which are aimed at strengthening teacher education in India including preservice teacher education, inservice teacher education, institutional development, faculty development and policy.* Faculty are expected to contribute to the research, development, teaching and extension activities of CEIAR. They are expected to pursue their own independent research agendas, work closely with collaborators and state governments, design and offer courses of teacher professional development, and design and conduct research, guide students. Senior faculty are also expected to lead new academic initiatives and to develop new research projects for the Centre. Faculty appointments will be on contract initially for a period of one years which may be extended for an additional two year based on performance, review and need. Positions will be at the Centre in Mumbai Campus of TISS.

Professor/Associate Professor positions will be offered based on relevant qualifications and research/teaching/experience and publication record.

 - iv) Ten years of professional experience in Teacher Education
2. Associate Professor
 - i) Post graduate degree with minimum 55% marks in the discipline relevant to the area of specialisation.
 - ii) M.Ed with minimum 55% marks
 - iii) Ph.D in Education
 - iv) Eight years of professional experience in Teacher Education

A relaxation of 5% will be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for the SC/ST category candidates, and to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September 1991
