iCALL is a Field Action Project of the School of Human Ecology, Tata Institute of Social sciences. iCALL was established in September 2012 with the objective of providing accessible, affordable and quality counseling services to individuals in distress; particularly those who belong to marginalized communities. iCALL is a national-level telephonic and email-based facility that offers free counseling services to individuals in distress across the lifespan. This multilingual, free and confidential service is run by trained professionals who provide information, emotional support, therapeutic services and referral linkages.

Apart from service provision, iCALL also conducts research, capacity enhancement and awareness generation activities in the area of mental health in collaboration with State Governments, civil society organizations and International organizations such as UNOs.

Eligibility criteria/ Essential Qualifications:

- Possess a full-time postgraduate degree in Clinical/Counseling Psychology or Psychiatric Social Work from a UGC recognised University.
- Have 3-5 years of practical experience of service provision and work in the field of community mental health.
- Have offered supervision for at least a year to service providers working in the field of mental health and psycho-social support in recent times.
- Be fluent in English and Hindi and preferably any other Indian regional languages.
- Works with psychosocial lenses and right based perspective.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Good academic writing skills.

Job Responsibilities:

- Build capacities and supervise mental health and psycho-social support work undertaken by community care providers from India.
- Schedule and conduct regular and structured supervision sessions with the community based care providers.
- Provide support in planning and executing mental health and psycho-social support interventions with the community.
- Mapping progress of community care providers.
- Develop weekly reports of the supervision sessions.
- Ensure quality of documentation by community care providers throughout the supervision period.
- Provide online supervision for 8 hours per week.
- Update iCALL team of the work carried out by the community care workers and coordinate as per the tasks required.

The candidate shall report directly to the Programme Officers and Programme Associate at iCALL.

The position is initially for a period of 6 months and will be extended depending on project requirements. Please note that this is a part-time position.


