Required 'Assistant Professor (Economics)' (One post) on Contract Basis for the School of Habitat Studies at TISS-Mumbai Campus.

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences (www.tiss.edu), established in the year 1936 is a Deemed to be University, fully funded by the University Grants Commission, Govt of India. TISS is a Grade I University with NAAC score of 3.89/4 and is ranked 60 under NIRF University Rank Category for 2022.

With campuses at Mumbai (Main) and off-campus at Tuljapur, Guwahati and Hyderabad, TISS offers over 50 Post Graduate programmes, 18 Doctoral programmes, and 4 Under Graduate programmes in a range of socially relevant inter-disciplinary and applied social science disciplines, and over 30 B.Voc. programmes.

Freedom and autonomy shape the positive work ethos and culture of the Institute and facilitate strong linkages between teaching, research, field action and policy engagement. The Institute encourages and supports researchers to engage in foundational, applied, field and action-oriented research, and it also nurtures research collaborations nationally and internationally, with a commitment to creating a just society through education, generation of knowledge and field action initiatives.

The School of Habitat Studies, a centre for knowledge excellence, focuses on providing a comprehensive response to the knowledge-related needs of the society in the habitat sector. It draws from the fields of habitat studies, governance, economics, environmental science, the social sciences, engineering, architecture, and management. The key agenda of the School involves creation, dissemination, and application of relevant and useful knowledge about planning, design, development, management, regulation and governance of the habitats.

The School strives to develop professional capacities in the field of Habitat Studies through academic teaching and professional training that incorporate both social and technical skills through its four centres.

1. Centre for Regulatory Policy and Governance (CRPG)
2. Centre for Water Policy and Governance (CWPG)
3. Centre for Environment, Climate Change and Sustainability Studies (ECC&SS)
4. Centre for Urban Policy and Governance (CUPG)
5. Centre for Science, Technology and Society (CSTS)

The School offers four Master's Degree programmes conducts its research, capacity building, advocacy and analytical work through these Centres and one research facility.

The **School of Habitat Studies** invites applications from interested scholars for **ONE** post of **'Assistant Professor' in the field of Economics** to be filled on contract basis, initially for a period upto 31 May 2024 and extendable based on performance of the candidate and requirements of the Institute.

Remuneration:- Consolidated salary of Rs. 81,624/- p.m. (Pay Band Rs. 15,600 – 39,100/- with AGP Rs. 6,000/- in 6th CPC as approved by funder).

Educational Qualification:

Essential Qualification:-

A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in **Economics** from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, Eligibility (A or B)

A. The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET / SLET / SET for recruitment and appointment of 'Assistant Professor' subject to the or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)

the Times Higher Education (THE) or

the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Desirable Qualifications:

The candidates having Ph.D. in Economics and related subjects, preferably with focus on public policy or governance. A proven track record of research and teaching in quantitative methods will be an advantage.

The candidate should be able to teach courses related to different fields of economics, like macro-micro economics, regulatory economics, urban economics, quantitative economics, financial economics and others. A familiarity with subjects such as regulatory policies, economic regulation, urban policies, natural resource economics, institutional economics and their interface with societal realities and the preparedness to work with an interdisciplinary team and participate in theory as well as field-based teaching is a must.

The selected incumbent is expected to teach courses linked to basic economics (macro & micro), regulatory economics, urban economics, sectoral regulation and other related courses for post-graduate students of the following programmes of the School: Regulatory Policy and Governance, Urban Policy and Governance, Climate Change and Sustainability Studies, Water Policy and Governance. Apart from the School-wide contribution, the selected incumbent is expected to focus on research and development of the Regulatory Policy and Governance Programme.

Application Fee:

The application fee of Rs. 1000/- be paid online. The application fee for SC/ST/PWD candidates will be Rs. 250/- if they attach the required certificate to the online application form. The women applicants are waived from payment of application fees. The application will be valid only on receipt of the application fee, if applicable. Fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Other Conditions:

The Institute reserves the right to relax the qualifications of the candidate based on the work experience and to relax age in the case of persons already holding comparable positions in a University/Research Institution of repute.

The Institute reserves the right to invite persons for interviews who may not have applied as per the above procedure and not fill up the vacancy advertised.

Since applications received may be short-listed, merely possessing the prescribed qualifications & the requisite experience would not entitle a person to be called for the Interview.

The post is unreserved, but candidates belonging to the reserved category can apply.

No queries or correspondence regarding the issue of call letter for interview/selection of candidates for the post will be entertained at any stage and canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and will lead to the candidate being debarred from consideration for the post.

The candidate under employment must produce a 'No Objection Certificate' from their employer to appear for an interview.

No TA/DA is payable for appearing for the interview.

In case of any inadvertent error in the advertisement and in the process of recruitment, which may be detected at any stage, even after issuing the appointment order, the Institute reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate(s).
