WALK IN INTERVIEW FOR ADHOC ASSISTANT PROFESSOR – Hyderabad Campus

The Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) was established in 1936 and became a Deemed University in 1964. It is fully funded by the University Grants Commission of the Government of India. Currently, TISS offers **53** Master's Degree and 18 M.Phil. and Ph.D. programmes in a range of socially relevant inter-disciplinary areas from its Main Campus in Mumbai, and the Off-Campuses in Tuljapur, Guwahati and Hyderabad. Bachelor's programmes in Social Sciences and Social Work are offered from its Off Campuses. A high degree of freedom and autonomy shape the positive work ethos and creativity in the Institute facilitating strong linkages between teaching, research, field action and dissemination. The Institute provides significant space and resources for basic and policy research and has research collaboration with some of the best universities and institutions across the globe.

TISS provides work opportunities to scholars committed to creating a just society through education, generation of knowledge and field action.

The Hyderabad campus of TISS was inaugurated in 2012 and in the last seven years, it has expanded with several innovative Masters Degree programmes and a unique Under-Graduate programme in Social Sciences.

TISS Hyderabad off-campus invites applications from Indian nationals for **walk in interview** for the position of **ONE** Assistant Professor in the English Language Cell to be appointed on full-time and contractual basis initially for a period of one year which may be extended/reviewed based on the performance.

Date of Interview: Eligible candidate may register between 10.00 am and 10.30 am at Reception, 1st floor, TISS building, K.B. Campus, Turkayamjal, Nagarjuna Sagar Road, Hyderabad. PIN 501510 and attend **the walk in interview at 11 a.m. onwards on July 23, 2019**. Only those candidates meeting the minimum required qualifications will be allowed to appear for the walk in interview.

Documents for walk in interview:

The eligible candidates are required to bring the following documents for walk in interview:

1. An application expressing your interest in the position along with detailed resume stating education, employment, skills and three references.
2. Additional four copies of resumes stating education, employment, skills and three references.

3. A demand draft for Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One thousand only) as application processing fees, drawn in favour of 'Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Hyderabad campus', payable at Hyderabad.
4. One set of photocopies of educational and work experience certificates.
5. Two colour passport size photographs.
6. The originals of educational and work experience certificates for verification.

Educational Qualification:

Eligibility (A or B) :

A.

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Teaching of English as a Second Language/English Language Teaching / PGDTE (Post Graduate Diploma in Teaching English) / MA in Education with ELT Specialization or CELTA (Certificate in English Language Teaching) or DELTA (Diploma in English Language Teaching) from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET /SLET /SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor subject to the or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions fulfillment of the following conditions :-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

- B.** The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) theTimes Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

The candidate having Ph.D in English Language Education/ Education/ English/ English Teaching with three years of teaching or work experience in English Language domain and good publication record will be given preference.

Candidates should have specialized through their research and/or professional experience in one or more of the areas / fields listed above. We expect the faculty to focus on teaching, mentoring, conducting workshops on Academic English and research. Faculty should be interested in innovative curricular practices and customized language teaching for social science students.

No TA/ DA is payable for appearing for the interview.

The candidate must meet Essential Educational Qualification and specified work experience.

The selected candidates are expected to join within 15 days from the date of receiving the appointment letter.
