• **Project Objectives:** Brings equity in education in rural and marginalized communities.

- Designs and offers modular certificate courses, practice-based pedagogy courses, online mobile-based CoPs.

- teachers in middle and secondary government school, madrasas and tribal residential schools in areas with
 - a high incidence of migrant, tribal and scheduled caste communities
