Job Description for Research Officer

The research officer will closely work with the local community in Kalahandi and Nayagarh Districts of Odisha and will carry out independent research and policy advocacy work on community forest rights and governance. Broadly, the position requires to- (1) analyse the policy and institutional potential and challenges in the recognition and post recognition of community forest rights, (2) critically examine the livelihood and governance implications of community forest rights. The position requires intensive field work and discussion with government officers, Gram Sabha members, local NGOs and experts as per the requirement of the project.
